- Information we receive from third parties with respect to your account (such as trade confirmations from brokerage firms).

How We Use Information We Collect

In order to provide financial planning services to you, we may disclose personal information we collect and maintain in very limited instances, including:

- Disclosures authorized or requested by you (for example, to provide financial information in support of your mortgage loan application).
- Disclosures required by law (for example, to cooperate with regulators).
- Disclosures otherwise permitted by law as necessary to service your account (such as providing account information to a custodian like Schwab).

How We Protect Your Personal Information

We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect your personal information. We also limit access to personal information to employees and third parties as necessary or appropriate to provide services to you.
